Pool Operations Manual, April 2014, pages 21-23, Appendices E-G:

Swimming and Wading Pool Rules, Spa Pool Rules, and Sauna Rules (WAC 246-260-131(5)):

- 1. When used by children 12 years of age or under, a responsible adult, typically a parent, must be continuously present within the pool area enclosure. When used by children 13 through 17 years of age, an additional person aged 13 or older must be present (buddy system, or two person rule).
 - 2. No running or other horseplay is permitted.
 - 3. Use of the facility is prohibited while under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- 4. Use of the facility while ill with vomiting or diarrhea within the last two (2) weeks is prohibited.
 - 5. No food or drink, except water, is allowed in the pool.
- 6. A hot shower with soap is required before entering the water. "If you don't want to swim in it, wash it off your body."
 - 7. Nude use only.
- 8. Infants and toddlers requiring diapers shall use swim diapers to prevent contamination of the pool.
 - 9. Diapers must be changed in the dressing room.
- 10. Anyone not adhering to these rules is subject to dismissal from the area. Continual violation of these rules may cause ejection from the park.
 - 11. Emergencies:
- a. Location of the nearest emergency phone is the Kitchen pay phone (no charge to call 911). Cell phones may be used. Address: 24050 SE 127th Street, Issaquah; Park Phone: 425-392-6833, or your cell phone number. Have someone inform the Welcome Center and the Pool Chair (Jeff Flanders, 425-773-4610), Building and Grounds Chair (Eric Merk, 253-335-9555), and/or Park Board member.
 - b. First Aid kit is located in the Sauna Dressing Room.
- 12. Patrons with seizure, heart or circulatory problems should only swim with a buddy who is aware of the condition.
